Tickets: All seating is general admission. Tickets may be purchased at the gate the day of the event. Advance Tickets are available by contacting the office at 608.786.1525.

Group Rates: If you are interested in bringing a large group of guests to an event, group rates are available. Contact the Speedway office for more information.

Hospitality: Corporate Hospitality Packages are available, including ticket, meal, and a private location for your guests. Contact the Speedway office for a detailed Hospitality Brochure, or download it at lacrossespeedway.com. Choose from four different locations, and accommodations are available for groups as small as 12 and as large as 800.

Payment Options: Cash, Credit or Debit Cards are accepted (Credit & Debit Cards Accepted at Box Office #1). Personal Checks are not accepted.

Parking: Acres of close FREE Parking are available.

Handicap: The Speedway grandstand is Handicap friendly, and there is a designated Handicap parking area adjacent to the grandstand entrance (please display your permit).

Food and Beverage: A variety of foods and beverages are available at the concession stands for your enjoyment. Sorry, carry-ins are not permitted.

Pit Passes: Pit passes are available at the pit gate entrance near turn four. The minimum age in the pits at any time is 10 years, and all under age 18 need a parent or guardian to fill out a minor's release prior to entry.

Family Seating Sections: There are several sections of Family designated seating available. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are not permitted in the designated area.

Visit with the Stars: All fans are welcome to the pit area after the conclusion of each event. It's a great opportunity to meet the drivers and crews and even get a few autographs!

The Kwik Trip NASCAR Late Models are the premier division in competition. They are fabricated from ground up as made-for-racing machines, using a maximum 362 cubic inch engine, slick race tires, and use race car bodies that appear like many current production street cars.



The North Country Contractors Sportsmen are the middle division at the Speedway. The starting point is a street car production frame from cars made in 1980's & 1990's and use bodies from many street cars during that time. Engine and other restrictions differentiate them from Late Models.



United Auto Supply Thunderstox are the top weekly class that race on the tight quarter mile track. These cars are strictly stock, with only modest modifications made for safety. Engines are stock as well, and most of these cars are right off the street from the 1970's, 80's and 90's.



Window World Hornets are four-cylinder engine cars right off the street, with a maximum wheelbase measurement of 103 inches (wheel to wheel). The only modifications allowed are for driver safety, such as roll bars, seat belts and a window net. Then paint it up and go racin'!



Volden Construction Outlawz is the speedway's newest racing division. Many tracks have a "run what you bring" division without any rules or engine restrictions. That is exactly what the Outlaws are. The only rule is they must have a roll cage and standard driver safety equipment.

From Interstate 90, Westbound: Take Exit 12 (West Salem). Go south to three way intersection, turn right (west) on Cty Rd. C. Go 1.3 miles, turn right (north) at three way intersection onto Cty. Hwy M. The speedway is about 1 mile ahead, on the left, past the stoplight.

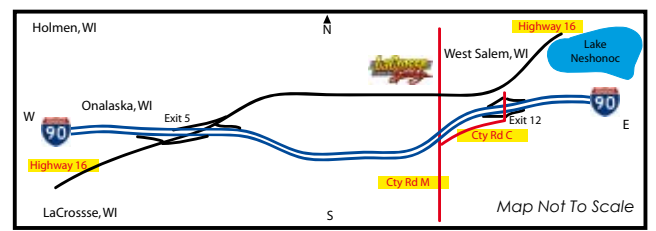
From Interstate 90, Eastbound: Take Exit 5 (Onalaska). Turn left (east) onto Hwy 16, and drive 4.5 miles to West Salem. At Stoplight, turn left, go 1/4 mile, and the Fairgrounds is on the left.

From the South or North: Take the safest route to Interstate 90 or Hwy 16 and follow the directions above.
